The improvement in other active stocks ranged from 1 to 2. In the afternoon Mississ. Pacific was rallied down. This weakened the entire market. At the same time it was reported from the west that the weather there was unfavorable for growing corn, which led to some selling on long account. Prices declined 1 to 2 per cent from the highest points of the day. Near the close there was a rally of 1 to 2 per cent. The latter Union Pacific market closed steady.
