Stocks—more active than any previous day for the week. There were a few slight reactions and there was a temporary decline of 1% in Northern Pacific preferred, but the general course of prices was upward and an advance of 1% to 3% was made. Anthracite coal stocks were the most prominent features and scored the greatest improvement. The recommendation of the 3 per cent sixty year funding scheme for the Pacific roads by the senate judiciary committee, the restoration of eastbound freight rates at Chicago and other western points and the reduction in the Bank of England discount, all tended to stimulate an upward movement which was assisted by free purchases to cover short contracts.
