The opening prices to-day were generally 1 1/4 per cent lower on account of the general impression that the outlook for a peaceful solution of the difficulties between England and Russia were favorable, and the advance in London of the price of British consols. Some activity was developed by an effort on the part of speculators to sell a profit in current quotations to realize, but after the first hour the market became very dull and fluctuated generally within an extremely narrow limit.
