WHERE THE WAR WILL BE. Facts that Have Been Developed by the Boundary Commission.

Herat, the "Gate of India," and its Fortifications--The Bearing of the New Facts on the Difficulty. Detroit Free Press.

The tract involved in the boundary dispute lies mainly between the two streams called the Heri-Rud, or river of Herat, and the Murghab, or River of Merv, each named for the chief city of its banks.

Both flow in courses of general parallelism to the mountains of Afghanistan, to the westward and northward, the latter lost in the sands of the Hyrcanian Steppes or Khivan Desert. The Heri-Rud rises in the highlands Hazara, and for many miles, runs nearly due west, between the ranges of the Safed-Koh, or White Mountains, and the Shah-Koh, or Black Hills, both westward extensions of the Hindu Kush.

The Murghab has its source in the ancient Pampanisus of the Greeks, the present name of the Afghan river, or Safed-Koh. It is divided into upper and lower Murghab at the village of Marchan ("the snake well"), above Penjdeh. Until near the latter place its valley is narrow and shut in by rounded hills, pushing down from the higher country, which at times reduce the river valley to a mere defile, but at Herat, the valley opens out, and thenceforward to the desert it is one to four or five miles wide, richly fertile, and once highly cultivated.

The major part of the tract between these two principal waters from Herat to the desert, is called the Badkhis district from the nomadic tribe chiefly inhabiting it. It is 100 to 150 miles in width from west to east, and until about a century ago supported a large, especially in population, as is indicated by numerous earth mounds and other ruins of villages and cities.
