Foreign Exchange—Sterling bills dull, at \$4.61; demand, \$4.57.

Governments—Quiet but strong, final quotations showing a slight advance in most cases, except a decline of 4¢ in currency.

Stocks—Stocks were weak during the early part of the day, but recovered a portion of the loss in the last two hours. A steady drive, accompanied by some realization, has been made to date against some of the leading active stocks, notably Lackawanna, which declined nearly two per cent. The general list opened weak and dull, and without any important reactions during the day slowly but steadily gained on limited transactions until after 2 o'clock, when there was a more decided break in the more active stocks, which was checked only a few minutes before the close of the board. In the final transactions there was a rally of 4¢ to 5¢, with Lackawanna gaining 4¢, and the market finally closed barely steady at the improved quotations.
