

A DAY OF GREAT DEPRESSION

But Very Little Business Transacted Yesterday on 'Change in Chicago.

PRICES SLIDE DOWN EASILY.

Wheat, Corn and Provisions Slow and Lower - Cattle Barley Hold Their Own, With Hogs Active and Higher.

CHICAGO GRAIN MARKET.

CHICAGO, July 16.—Special Telegram to the BEE.—WHEAT—Depression was more or less a pronounced feature in the wheat market to-day, and as a consequence, the direction taken by prices was somewhat downward. But business was so light here and so unimportant in any section or denoted movements. The heavy receipts and the same conditions prevailing at larger primary points, made holders anything but stiff in their views, so lower prices came very easy and natural. August ran down during the morning from 79 1/2 to 78 3/4, but later recovered to 79 1/2. The fluctuations during the last hour were a half cent to a range of 1/2. The pit was very dull, and around the floor little or nothing was talked about. The recovery from 78 3/4 to 79 1/2 is on the report that five boats had been taken at New York for export.

CORN—Corn was a little less strong than yesterday on reported rains in the southwest, where the previous damage by drought was not so heavy as reported. The market which opened at 86, sold for this reason down to 85 1/2, but subsequently improved a little. PROVISIONS—Provisions were very slow and a featureless sort of a deal, the principal option in pork only moving 1/2 and the general tendency being up and down in sympathy with wheat. The close all around was a little.

CHICAGO LIVE STOCK.

CHICAGO, July 16.—[Special Telegram to the BEE.]—CATTLE—The market is certainly no better," said a salesman who had just weighed at 85 1/2, a pair of 1549 lb steers. Another man sold 137 lb steers at \$4.03, the same as last week, and yesterday. In one or two instances today, fat 1620 to 1520 lb steers sold more rapidly, and at fully as good prices as on yesterday. Some 1065 lb Wyoming meal-fed cattle sold at \$4.20, being about the same as some of the same brand sold Wednesday at the same price. The market in a general way was quiet, and most salesmen contented with the course and that cattle were harder to sell. Shippers did very little business to-day, the amount of 1447 to 1222 lb heaves at \$4.76, 248 1/2, mostly at inside figures, looks bad to men who have had to make prime heaves. Nebraska averaging 1048 to 1191 lbs sold at \$4.00 to \$4.55. During the early days of the week rangers suffered considerably, and the market was somewhat steadier and to-day prices were in some cases a shade higher. Men who sold some of their cattle thought the canners at least were about 1/2 higher. The receipts to-day were about 1,400 head, most of which were sold early.

STOCKS—Stocks opened with a more decided feeling in favor of higher prices, the more harmonious relations with the Chicago Atlantic seaboard market, and the fact in Erie. Extensive buying for London accounts was also a factor in the rise of the morning. The market became too top heavy to suit readers, and prices were lifted the entire middle, the market sinking into the usual midsummer dullness until Western Union was again taken hold of, and the entire market. After the movement in Western Union the market went along slowly and closed about steady.
