The fifty mile race between Albert Schock and John S. Prince, the champion long distance rider, attracted about 700 people to the exposition building last night.

THE WORK OF CHOOSING SCORERS, TIMEKEEPERS, ETC., BEING DISPOSED OF, THE TRACK WAS CLEARED. THE SELECTIONS MADE WERE AS FOLLOWS: Scorers, A. C. Joliffe, F. M. Shaw, timekeepers, Perry Badollet, T. T. Mellon, referees, Horace Schock, F. T. Parmelee, judges, George E. Kay.

THE FIFTY MILE RACE BEGAN AT 7:30 P.M. THE RACE WAS RUN ON THE TRACK AT THE EXPOSITION BUILDING LAST NIGHT. PRINCE GAVE HIS ANTAGONIST ONE MILE START AT THE START.
