ADDITIONAL COUNCIL BLUFFS ANOTHER MOVE.

A Normal School For Council Bluff and a \$40,000 Building.

The suggestions made by President Atkins, of the board of education, in 1.0gard to putting up a new building, have met with bearty approval by some of the leading citizens and heavy taxpayers. A petition has been prepared setting forth clearly the plans in general, and this has been signed by a large number of the most prominent citizens, who seem enthusiastic in the propositions to be submitted to the vote of the people. The propositions are to be voted on at the school-elections which takes place next

month, a week after the city election. The following is the petition presented to the board at its meeting last night, and in accordance with which the ques-tions as there stated will be presented to the voters to decide upon at the polls. The names signed to the same are so numerous that space torbids their repro-

duction: To the Honorable School Board of the City of Council Bluffs, Ia.:-We, the undersigned citizens and taxpayers of said city, respect-fully request you to submit to the qualified electors of said city, at the an nual school election next ensuing, the following proposi-

tions: L. Shall the board of directors of the independent school district of Council Bluffs, Ia, be authorized and empowered to lease the high school building, with the necessary grounds, for a period of ninety-nine years, at a rental of 1 cent per annum, to be used as a normal school. 2. Shall the board of directors of said inde-

2. Shall the board of directors of said inde-pendent school district of Council Buffs, Ia., be authorized and directed to sell so much of the high school grounds as they shall deem best, and use the proceeds thereof in the erco-tion of a school building, with a high school department, on the Washington Avenue (Mill) school grounds, 3. Shall the board of directors of the inde-andent school district of the soft of the inde-

pendent school district of the city of Council Bluffs. Ia., be authorized and directed to issue the bonds of said district in the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) or so much thereof as shall be necessary, with the pro-ceeds of the sale of the High school grounds, to complete the construction of a school building, with a high school department, on the Washington Avenue (Mill) school grounds.

The reasons urged for this move are numerous. The Mills school building is pronounced unfit for further use, its san-itary conditions being especially bad. It needs to be replaced by a new building. The schools are so crowded with pupils that more rooms are needed, and to meet this imperative need it is deemed best to substitute a large building on this site. The site is one peculiarly central for the establishment of a school building where grades are to be taught which draw pupils from all parts of the city. The high school building is not located conveniently for many parts of the city, and pupils from near by are obliged to do climbing which is by no means condu-cive to health or happiness. It is urged hat the way seems open for establishing here a normal school, which will bring to this city several hundred young ladie and gentlemen who desire to fit them-selves for teaching, and thus an institution will be established of great benefit to the city. The proposal is to give the board authority to lease it at a nominal board authority to lease it at a nominal sum, for a term of years, the ownership of the building to remain in the city, so if it is not used for the purposes stated in the lease, there can be no difficulty in the city regaining possession of it. The chief reasons, therefore, are that this move will lead to the establishment of a normal school in Council Bluffs, and will at the same time furnish a larger and better located building to meet the needs

better located building to meet the needs of the city schools. Added to these rea-sons is also given the additional one that it will help the prosperity of the city by showing that the city has faith in its own future, The finances of the school board are

Identifying the Suicide. There seems to be some difficulty in establishing the identity of the man who recently committed suicide at Malvern. ### The City Council.

Last evening the city council met, with all the members present except Alderman Straub.

There was considerable talk about the levee. The city attorney reported that he did not consider the contract made in 1882 with Mr. Moore as now binding for the construction of the levee.
