## SEWER WORKMEN ON STRIKE

About Two Hundred Men at Lincoln Go Out For Higher Wages.

**NEW COMPANIES INCORPORATED** 

A Traveling Man Attaches His Own Grip to Secure His Wages-A Hotel Thief Captured-Lincoln News.

IFROM THE BEE'S LINCOLN BUREAU. At noon yesterday a large number of the workmen in sewer construction struck for higher wages, the striking men numbering, as near as could be ascertained at that time 200 and their demands being for an advance in wages from \$1.50 to \$1.75 per day's work of ten hours. There are at present some 400 or 500 men in the employ of the sewer contractor, and the work for the past two months has been pushed with all possible rapidity. The sewerage work in the city the authorities desire to have completed as early as men can do it, and for this reason it is hoped that the pending difficulties may be settled with as little delay as possible.
