

THE COMMISSIONERS IN JAIL.

Douglas County's Legislators Make a Thorough Inspection.

THEIR JURISDICTION DENIED.

Mr. Hitchcock Refuses to Recognize the Board—Too Much Money Paid Out For Feeding the Prisoners.

Cursting Expenses. The county commissioners assembled yesterday morning to listen to any charges that might be preferred against Sheriff Coburn or his deputies, but after waiting a considerable time no one appeared and the board adjourned until 2 o'clock this afternoon.

Mr. G. M. Hitchcock, editor of the World, was seen at his office and asked if he would present his charges and evidence against Joe Miller to the county commissioners. Mr. Hitchcock said that he would not. In the first place the commissioners had not asked him to and in the next place, he upon the advice of County Attorney Simeral could not recognize the jurisdiction of the county commissioners. The case must ultimately come before the grand jury, at which time the evidence in his possession must be produced and when it is so publicly made, would greatly weaken his case. Mr. Hitchcock further stated that he had preferred no charge against Sheriff Coburn. He was only after Joe Miller and could not understand why the county attorney should endeavor to resolve to inquire into Mr. Coburn's official conduct, so far as the World's charges concerning the jail were concerned.

Shortly after 11 o'clock the commissioners, accompanied by a Bee representative, made a tour of inspection of the jail. Everything was found in excellent shape except the vases and petty offenders sent up from the police court. The misery of these poor wretches is beyond description. Sixty-five men are confined in a filthy, narrow cage, that was designed to accommodate but twenty-four. The stench in this part of the prison is disgusting. One named Fred Engle is fairly rotten with scum foul disease. His limbs are black and appear to be in the first stages of putrefaction. The odor that comes from the incarcerated men is overpowering. Forty-one of these prisoners are obliged to sleep on the wet floor, in the bath tub or remain standing throughout the long cold nights. There is not a single one of these prisoners but is covered with vermin. At least twenty of them were engaged searching their bodies for vermin, and one prisoner exhibited to the county commissioners a blue flannel shirt, on which there was at least one hundred of the insects.

Of course, the above terrible state of affairs cannot be blamed to the jailer. The jail is overcrowded and he is obliged to put the prisoners, sent from the police court, somewhere. Judge Berka continues to send along the vases and huns, and the limited accommodations are entirely inadequate. County Attorney Simeral brought before the judges of the district court a proposition to introduce into the county jail new rules by which prisoners would be obliged to do hard manual labor. Police Judge Berka has been instructed, that in sentencing prisoners to include the words, "at hard labor." Mr. Simeral believes that this will keep the regular offenders out of the jail and lessen the cost of maintaining the institution. This new rule cannot effect the very men it should, viz. the drunk and vagabond. The city council passes an ordinance to that effect.

AFTERNOON SESSION. At a quarter before 5 o'clock in the afternoon the commissioners resumed to consider any charges that might be made against the sheriff, or substantial proofs of the vague allegations against Jailer Joe Miller. Mr. Hitchcock, of the World, did not appear, and no more charges presented by a taxpayer, as the law stipulates and invites.

The following report submitted by the committee on court house and jails was referred to the county attorney for his opinion: "Mr. Chairman: After careful deliberation the committee on court house and jail has decided that the expense of boarding prisoners in the county jail is excessive; therefore be it..."

Resolved, That on and after January 15, 1888, 50 cents per day shall be allowed for each prisoner limited to six days or less, and 25 cents per day for each prisoner exceeding six days. The report was signed by Commissioners Anderson, Turner and Corrigan.

Commissioner Anderson presented the appended resolution which was adopted: "Resolved, That the county attorney be and is hereby requested to present his opinion in writing to this board in regard to the advisability and locality of works for city prisoners now confined in the county jail and those that may be hereafter confined therein; also should the city prisoners be boarded at the expense of the county. If not what steps should be taken to place the expense where it rightfully belongs.

The commissioners to a man are warmly in accord with the foregoing resolutions, and they are beginning to think that the county tax-payers have been imposed upon long enough and have enough. One of the commissioners, Anderson, turned to the reporter: "The causes that lead me to introduce that resolution are that I feel the county is paying too much for the feeding of its prisoners. We are paying more than any other county in the west. There will be a margin and profit left for the sheriff even at the prices we propose to adopt."

"How did you find things in the jail to-day?" was asked of Mr. Anderson, who is chairman of the jail committee. "Well," he replied, "myself and Commissioners, Turner, Mount and O'Keefe put in about an hour looking the interior and prisoners over. We did not count our vases, but will make another investigation in a day or two, when the jail committee will make a report."

"Did you have a talk with the prisoners?" "Oh, I spoke with one or two of them." "What did they have to say as to their treatment in the jail?" "One of them said it was a hell-hole."

Here Commissioner Mount interrupted with the information that the individual who referred to the place as a hell-hole was a chronic drunk by the name of McGuire, who spends seven-eighths of his time in jail for petty offenses.

Resuming the conversation with Commissioner Anderson the reporter asked him if the prisoners were interviewed in reference to the abuses alleged and if they were backed at the jail. To this interrogation Mr. Anderson replied: "I did not question them closely. This visit was more to acquaint ourselves with the crowded condition of the jail, and the sanitary relations of the prisoners. We found many of them in bad shape, and covered with vermin. This of course prevails in the 'bum cage,' where prisoners set up from the police court are confined. Nearly all these characters are city charges, and it strikes me as wrong, as it does my companion commissioners, that the county should be taxed to keep them. If the commissioners find that they have any redress, the taxpayers of the county may rest assured that we will pursue and dispel this barnacle."

Chairman O'Keefe is also anxious that the amount paid for board and cell charges to the prisoners should be cut down. Mr. Coburn's bill for feeding prisoners during the month of December was over \$2,000, and in the estimation of the commissioners is too much money. By law Mr. Coburn is entitled to 75 cents a day for feeding prisoners receiving six days sentences, and 50 cents for everyone over that period. A majority of the prisoners, Mr. O'Keefe says, are those set up from the police court and are fed for days and weeks on bread and water, at an average cost to the sheriff of 5 cents a day, leaving him a clear profit on each prisoner of 45 cents a day. This the commissioners claim is an imposition on the county tax-payers, in so much as they are taxed for the maintaining of prisoners that are strictly and legitimately the charges of the city.

The Omaha Fair Not Abandoned. The report which has recently gained credence that the Omaha Fair and Exposition association had decided to abandon its annual fair was pronounced yesterday by Secretary McShane as unfounded. The association intend to maintain the annual exhibition with the additional determination of making every one of them

more interesting as the years go by. The report, it is thought, was based upon the announced determination, made some time ago, of the dealers in agricultural implements to make no more exhibits at either state or county fairs. What the association now means is a better place in which to hold its annual fairs, and it will retain its present grounds until a more desirable place can be obtained.

OMAHA, Jan. 13.—To the Public: Section 15, chapter 49, Chase's compilation, requires all sidewalks to be cleaned of snow and ice, within one hour after the cessation of any storm or fall of snow unless such storm or fall of snow shall take place in the night time, in which case the sidewalks shall be cleaned by 9 a. m. the following day. A non-compliance will be treated as a misdemeanor and upon conviction a fine can be imposed not to exceed \$25. The chief of police has been instructed to enforce the ordinance.
