M., Feb. 28.—[Special Telegram to The Ber.]—A joint memorial to the president and congress of the United States praying for the establishment of a new land office for the counties of Socorro and Valen-cia, and to be located at the city of Socorro has passed the legislature. The bill has passed both branches of the legislature creating an emigration commission and appropriating \$10,000 for advertising the resources of the territory. The senate yesterday confirmed, under the new law, the six district attorneys of the territory. R. E. Twitchell, of Santa Fe, will act as solicitor-general until October next, when the power of the governor to appoint takes effect.
