A BEGGARS' TRUST.

A Queer Organization in the City of Paris. A Paris letter to the New York Tribune says: The existence for a number of years of a beggars' trust in Paris has recently been discovered. This news has spread alarm to many households which have been the victims of misdeeds and robberies. In most of the church doors during divine service a ragged group of mendicants is always to be encountered, and the routing of this pauper gawdies forms one of the most disagreeable of experiences.

Two trustees of this corporation, so-called, has been discovered by the chief of police, into whose hands have fallen documents containing much valuable information as to a regularly organized beggars' guild, with headquarters in the city of Paris. The system is well organized and has been in existence a number of years. Each Parisian district is patrolled by a beggar lieutenant, who has supreme control of his jurisdiction. Ben Butler as Se'n in Washington.

Ben Butler has not yet sold his big house opposite the Capitol to the government, but he gets a nice lot of money as Uncle Sam all the same, and his mansion contains some of the most comfortable committee rooms of the lower house, writes a Washington correspondent of Chicago Herald. The building is a handsome one, and the money for it is a \$2,000 a year in taxes. It had for a long time a mortgage of \$50,000 on it, and this was given by Butler to raise money for his last presidential campaign. He said that his gubernatorial campaign cost him \$100,000 apiece. He can afford, however, to spend money in politics, for he makes it, it is said, \$100,000 a year at the law, and takes away a half every time he goes to court. He has a practice before the supreme court. I saw him in one of the departments the other day. He is looking fat and healthy, and he had a bouquet in his buttonhole as usual. He wore a big coat every time he went out, and a fur collar in the winter. He is now seventy-one years old, but looks as though he might last for twenty years and he is as strong physically and mentally as he was during the war. He works because he likes it and he will probably keep up his practice until he dies.

Origin of the Names of Fabrics.

Very few dry goods men know the origin of the names of many of the goods they sell. They may say, for example, that they are of interest to the man who seeks to be thoroughly familiar with the merchandise in which he deals. Damask is from the city of Damascus; calico is from Calicut, a city in India; muslin is celebrated for its cotton cloth and where called was also printed. Muslin is named from Mosul in Asia. Alpaca, from an animal in Peru, of the llama species, from whose wool the fabric is woven; buckram takes its name from Fostat, a city of the middle ages, from which the modern Cairo is descended. Taffeta and tulle are named from a street in Baghdad, Cambria from Cambria, because its name from Gambia; crepe is named from Crepe, a town in France; and serge is derived from a city in Ireland, Drogheda. Duck comes from Turkey, in Normandy. Blanket is called after Thomas Blanket, a famous clothier connected with the city of Drogheda, who introduced into England a famous serge derived from a peculiar woolen blanket. Diaper is not from D'Ypres, as it is sometimes stated, but from the Greek diaperon, figured with a check or a grid. Flannel is from the Latin flannel, a hide or pelt. Shawl is the Sanscrit sala, floor, for shawls were first used as carpets and to bind or tie, because it is tied in knots before dyeing. Chamois is from the Indian chamois. Delaine is the French for wool.
