Off of Peppermint.

When it is said that nine-tenths of all the oil of peppermint used in the world comes from one little county in New York state, it asems quite improbable, yet such is a fact, and, at that, the test quality only, says a Rochester

letter to the Pittaburg Disputch. But a short distance east of this city is located Lyons, the county seat of Wayne county, whose name comes from the revolutionary here, General Anthony Wayne, who, by his busite, earned the southriquet of "Mad Antony." It is a small county, but is one of the leading in point of agriculture in the great Empire state. Over 159,000 pounds of the cit is now distilled in Wayne county each year, in favorable seasons. The crop is one that returns a fancy profit to the farmer, who nover gots below \$2 a pound for his oil, and from that price to \$4 and \$5. Twenty-five pounds of cit to the acre is the lowest average of the crop, and frequently it is double that.

Can Never Be President.

There are four members of the United States senate who can never be candidates for the presidency of this republic, under the constitution, because of alien birth, says the Pittsburg Dispatch. Senator Jones of Nevada was born in Herefordshire, England; General MeMillan of Michigan in Hamilton, Outario, Senator Beek of Kentucky in Mumpfriesshire, Scotland, and Senator Pasco of Florida in London, England. While it is the exception rather than otherwise that a senator was born in the state he represents, sectional lines have been closely observed. Of the northern senators only two were born in the south—Senator Cullem of Illiands, in Kentucky, and Sonator Hawlew of Connecticut, in North Carolina. Not one southern senator is of northern origin.

Seed Corn 4,000 Years Old.
During the senson of 1889 a most remarkable crop was raised by David Drew, at Plymouth, N. H. In 1888 Mr. Prew came into possession of some corn grains found warpped with a mammy in Egypt, supposed to be 4,000 years old, says the St. Louis Republic. These were planted and grew. It had many of the characteristics of real corn; the leaves were alternate; it grew to be over arx feet high; the mid-ribs were white; but the product of the stalk—there is where the curious part comes in. Instead of growing in an earlise modern maize, it hung in heavy clusters at the top, on skikelets; there was no tassel; no silk; each sprig was thickly studded with grains, each provided with a separate husk, like wheat grains.
