Thrust and Perry in Congress Over the Proposed Shipping Subsidy Bill.

NARROW SUPPORT FOR THE SPEAKER.

Substitute for the Senate Bill Reported to the House—How the Appropriations Failed in the Senate.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 27.—In the house this morning the senate bill was passed and the substitute for the senate bill reported to the house.

The house substitute for the senate bill was read by paragraph for amendment.

Mr. Herbert of Alabama offered an amendment withdrawing the subsidy from sailing vessels and confining it to steamships.

Mr. Clarno of California offered an amendment providing that payments shall not be made for more than 1400 miles sailed on either outward or inward voyage.

Mr. Struble of Iowa offered an amendment providing for the measurement of distances to be made in accordance with the shortest practicable route.

Mr. Rogers of Arkansas offered an amendment providing that the crew of the vessel shall be citizens of the United States.

An amendment by Mr. Struble, providing that the owners and officers of any ship receiving bounty shall have no interest in any cargo carried, was lost.

An amendment by Mr. Governor, providing that no sailing vessel of less than 1000 tons, gross tonnage, shall be entitled to the benefits of the act, was lost.

An amendment by Mr. New York, providing that the vessel shall be of American shipping by which the classification and standing of vessels to be certified to the board of underwriters of New York, Boston, Philadelphia, New Orleans and San Francisco.

At 5 o'clock the committee rose and reported the bill to the house without amendment.

Mr. Farquhar formally offered the house substitute for the senate bill.

Mr. Springer made a point of order that this bill Friday the house was in recess until 10 o'clock.

Then the house became a scene of confusion, growing out of the parliamentary tactics of Mr. Fitzhugh of Illinois.

Mr. Fitzhugh of Illinois obtained permission to offer a free ship substitute, which was lost.

The house substitute was then agreed to, 141 yeas, 10 nays.

The senate bill was amended by the substitute to its third reading, the yeas and nays being 141 yeas, 10 nays.

At the last moment Mr. Dingy changed his vote to the negative, and the speaker announced the vote to be 142 yeas, 10 nays.

The announcement was greeted with wild applause by the democrats, and Mr. Dingy was congratulated by the democrats.
