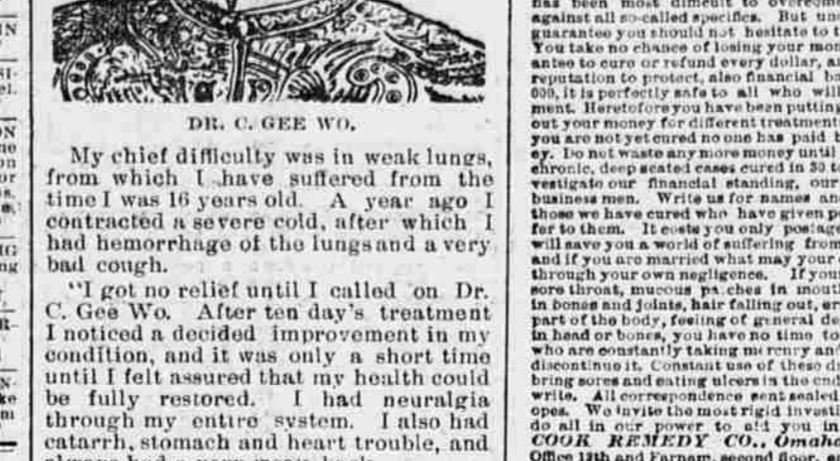

The Greatest Authors Make the Least Excusable Mistakes. "A cat may look at a king," they say.

The principal mistakes of writers are anachronisms, says the New York Voice. While many of these anachronisms are blunders more or less simple, others have been purposely made for "art's sake."

Virgil seems to have been the earliest writer who was guilty of an anachronism. In the Aeneid he makes Dido and Aeneas contemporaries, whereas Dido lived 247 years after the Trojan war.

In Coriolanus act 1, scene 4, he makes Titus Lartius, when extolling the valor of Coriolanus, say to him: "A soldier ever to Cato's wish."

"His may have been the fact, but, unfortunately for exactness, Coriolanus died a full century and a half before Alexander came into the world."

The most sovereign prescription of Confucius is confounded. A century and a half and two centuries out of the way is bad enough, but what shall we say of six centuries? Coriolanus was banished from Rome and died in the fifth century before the Christian era.
