WAITING FOR THE WITNESSES

Interests Commerce Commissioners Ready for a Session of Investigation.

CHARGES MADE AGAINST THE WABASH

Alleged Discriminations Made by That Road for the Benefit of Favored Grain Shippers-Chairman Veasey Explains the Commissioner's Work.

The Interstate Commerce Commission, represented by Judge J. C. McMill of Iowa, General W. G. Veasey of Vermont and Special Agent F. G. Kretschmer, is now holding a special session in this city for the purpose of investigating charges made against the Wabash railroad, alleging discriminations in the matter of shipping grain from Nebraska to Toledo.

The complaint was made public in the Chicago Tribune and later on by C. W. Varney, a grain shipper of Lincoln, and others. It alleged that the Wabash road has paid rebates and fictitious expense bills in various ways.

The Interstate Commerce Commission has taken up the case. "Whenever we receive a complaint that appears to be of a substantial nature," said General Veasey, "we make an investigation. We frequently find that these complaints are based upon supposition or error on the part of the complainant."

The commission began this investigation in Chicago, where General Manager Hays of the Wabash was placed under oath and their testimony taken. General Manager Hays has made a statement to the effect that the alleged discriminations were made on a case-by-case basis.

The investigation will probably be completed at St. Louis and Chicago, when the commissioners return from the coast.

What the Commission is Doing.

Speaking of the work of the commission General Veasey said: "We shall probably call upon some of the railroad officials in Omaha while we are here to talk over our matters and get their views on the case. Our work is never completed, you know. We have received more complaint recently against some of the fast freight lines of the country than we have against any other. We are told, however, that there has been a falling off in the cases of freight rate discriminations, and cuts of fully 50 per cent have been made on many lines."
