

## A LIFE SPENT FOR AN IDEA

Sketch of the Remarkable Career of the Priestess of This Epoch.

PEN PICTURE OF MME. BLAVATSKY  
Hesitate Career of the Mystic She-Her.  
Early Life and Later Accomplish-  
ments—Life Unusually De-  
voted to an Idea.

In a recent issue of the New York Sun William Q. Judge reviews the life and work of the late Mme. Blavatsky, the famous leader of the modern school of Theosophy. The writer brings to the work the enthusiasm of an admirer, if not a follower, and presents many interesting facts concerning the career of a remarkable woman of whom the general public had but a vague acquaintance.

Mme. Helena Petrovna Blavatsky, writes Mr. Judge, was born under the power of the holy Cross in the family of the Hahns, descended on one side from the famous crusader Count Hohenstein, who added Hahn a coat, to his name because that bird saved his life from a wary Serpent who had come into his tent to murder him.

## A Folly Stage.

"Hardly any circumstance of epoch in Mme. Blavatsky's career was prosaic. She chose to be born into this life at Ekaterinow, Russia, in the year 1831, when conflict and desolation were everywhere from the plague of cholera. The child was so delicate that the family decided upon immediate baptism under the rite of the Greek Catholic church."

This was in itself not common, but the ceremony was under the hand of the relatives who were present and holding lighted candles. As one was absent a young child, aunt of the infant Helena, was made proxy for the absentee, and given a candle like the rest. Tired out by the effort, this young proxy sank down to the floor unnoticed by the others, and just as the sponsors were renouncing the evil one on the babe's behalf, by three times spitting on the door, the sitting witness with her candle accidentally set fire to the robes of the officiating priest, and instantly there was a small conflagration, in which many of those present were seriously burned. Thus amid the scourge of death in the land was Mme. Blavatsky ushered into the world, and in the days ensuing by the priests of a church whose fallacious dogmas she did much in her life to expose.

## A Local Ward.

"As a child she was the wonder of the neighborhood and the terror of the simpler souls. Helena seems with superstitions and omens, and as Helena was born on the 27th of August, and between the 20th and 21st day, she was supposed by the nurses and servants to have powers and virtues possessed by no one else. And these supposed powers made her the cynosure of all in her early youth. She was allowed liberties given none others, and as soon as she could understand she was given by her nurses the chief part in a mystic Russian ceremony performed about the house and grounds on the 30th of July with the object of propitiating the house demon. The education she got was fragmentary, and in itself was so inadequate as to be one more cause among many for the belief of her friends that she was endowed with abnormal psychic powers, or else in reality assisted by those unseen beings who assisted her.
