The old self must be crucified and the new self brought to life.

WAS EATING HUSKS.

Sore Strain of a Youthful Bostonian Who Was Sealing the Country.

Last Saturday night Charles Robinson, a 16-year-old boy, was arrested for vagrancy and beggary on the streets. He was ragged, unkempt and dirty. He used good language and had the manners of a gentleman, but evidently had no money or the luxury of a bath since the last rain storm.

In reply to the questions of the police he said that he was not a vagrant and his father was a Baptist minister in Boston. He had left home six months ago to see the country and go to school. He had written home for money and was certain that it had been sent, but his wanderings had been so devoids that the letter must have gone astray. He spoke in a hesitating, uncertain manner, which, coupled with his unchristian appearance, made him suspect he was a bad boy.

The lad asked for a day or two of time before he was sent to jail to see if his money would come in. His request was granted, but not with the idea that anything would come of it.

He was allowed to make a meal for him at the jail. A letter carried with postmarks and "cannot be found" was left, and when opened a \$50 bill dropped out. The letter and money were turned over to the prison and he was given his liberty with the advice to go home to his parents and let the west alone.

OVER FOR THE WINTER.

Nebraska Central Field Corps Will Lay Up Until Springtime.

The Nebraska Central people have abandoned field work, the corps of surveyors coming in a few days ago. The men retained are devoting their labors at present to finishing up the accumulation of office work.

Civil Engineer Lawrence has been relieved for the present and will not resume field work until there is an improvement in the state of the weather. He may conclude to April 1.

The proposed main line of the Nebraska Central has been surveyed from Council Bluffs to Fort Dodge, Ia., by way of Avoca.

The surveying corps has been running another line by way of Carroll, Churdon and Coon Rapids in the hope of improving the road in that way. The surveys now indicate that the first intention is the best and will be carried out when construction begins.

President Dumont is now in the east and will return within a few days.
