John Hood Sherwood Will Have to Plead the Next Grand Jury.

WILL SPEND THE INTERIM IN JAIL

His Attorneys Raise a Novel Point in His Defense and a Governmental Official Says He Will Not Hold Together.

John Hood Sherwood had his preliminary hearing yesterday afternoon before Judge McGee on the charge of forging the name of John Van Kirk to a note of \$500 which he received from the Citizens' Loan Bank.

Without waiting to hear an argument on the question from the prosecution, Judge McGee stated that he thought it would be very poor policy for a court to decide that the passing of a note made out on Sunday would not be a criminal offense, even if the name signed were false, for it would render the banking business a very dangerous one and give notice to crooks all over the country.

The hearing then proceeded. C. B. Hamann, the cashier of the bank, and Mr. Van Kirk being the only witnesses who testified. Their testimony was substantially the same as their stories which have already been published.

The attorney for the prosecution has a contrary view of Sherwood's statement as to the day when the note was signed. Sherwood testified that he signed it on Monday, but the attorney for the prosecution says that he signed it on Sunday.
