Jobbing Business Very Satisfactory and Fully Up to the Standard of a Year Ago.

COLLECTIONS ARE GENERALLY QUITE EASY

Milder Weather Wanted to Put Still More Life into Business—Plenty of Work and General Activity in All Lines Anticipated for Summer.

Occasional complaints are heard of late to the effect that business in a jobbing way is not that it might be or all that those more interested would like to see. On the other hand, there are plenty of reports to the effect that the holding up remarkably well for the season. The facts in the case, as nearly as they can be learned, do seem to indicate that the volume of business is not as large as it was during the busiest part of the season. Hence, if a comparison is made between the present and some previous months there will be found to have been a decrease. But no one expects business to be as good in February as during the most active season of the year. If a comparison is made with February of last year it will be found that the present month is not behind in the volume of business transacted, and it will be remembered that a year ago at this time business was considered to be pretty good. It would appear, therefore, that business is at the present time fully up to last season, and that no cause for complaint can be found in present conditions.

It is the fact that business has held up as well as it has in this respect for contemplation. There are not many complaints of late that Omaha who are looking upon the matter in that light. The extremely cold weather of the past week has not so greatly retarded business as it has in previous years. Farmers and all kinds of retailers have had a good deal of the snap out of business. Farmers out through the country in the winter have had much cold weather only compelled to buy with necessity, and they put off buying and so without a good many things rather than face the expense of the cold. The weather will continue to be so until the severity of the winter is over.

It is very difficult to look at the situation fairly in the present and to see how far as possible the effect upon the city and state of the coming Columbian exposition. AS DEN SEES IT.

The Abuse of the Credit System—About Local Business Prospects.

The importance of this matter of credits is not appreciated outside the mercantile fraternity," said Mr. W. H. Roberson, Omaha manager of R. G. Dun & Co.'s mercantile agency, yesterday. "I have just been reading in the trade papers figures regarding the question. The credit system has been a great success, and it is useless to talk about doing the business of this or any other country on a cash basis. It is the abuse of credit that makes mercantile business so full of grief. On account of the universal interest in the matter, I have been asked to have a world's mercantile congress of credits, collections and failures as a feature of the Columbian exposition, and it is in connection with this that my attention has been especially directed to the figures mentioned.

It appears from the fairly accurate statistics compiled by the mercantile agencies in the amount of individual debts to retail dealers is \$20,000,000. Of this the wholesale merchants hold about \$10,000,000, including jobbing done by manufacturers. Retail dealers bear four-fifths, or \$13,000,000. The retailers' losses from bad debts are not computed in the statistics, but it is estimated that the credit guaranty companies estimate the annual losses at 2.5 to 3 per cent of the business transacted. The avoid losses wholesale dealers

utilize all the help possible in ascertaining credits. Their chief resource is of course the mercantile agencies, and on the general average of correct ratings of agencies credit companies. They contain a great deal of information given by this agency is safe for credit purposes, as experience for over twenty years has shown. Of course there are only two classes of losses—avoidable and unavoidable.
