PLATE CANAL CONSIDERED

Two Commissioners Decide Against Submitting the Project to the People.

SPECIAL SESSION OF THE COUNTY BOARD

City Council Promptly Passes an Ordinance Naming a Canal Commission—The Platte Project Opposed by Livesey and Williams.

The voters in the country precincts of Douglas county will be allowed to cast their ballots for or against the proposition of voting bonds to aid in the construction of the Platte river canal, simply for the reason that two of the county commissioners, Henry Livesey and C. R. Williams, have refused to allow the propositions to be submitted at the November election.

At a special meeting of the commission, held yesterday afternoon, Mr. Padlock was the only absentee. The lobby was well filled with members of the city council and city officials, watching and waiting to see if the board was willing that the people of the county should be allowed the privilege of expressing their views upon the subject.

Discussed the Project. D. H. Wheeler of the city council was invited to discuss the feasibility of the canal and in a few words said that it meant to Omaha what St. Anthony Falls meant for Minneapolis. It solved the question of cheap power for the city of Omaha in a position where she could compete with any of the eastern cities as a manufacturing center. He was of the opinion, however, that the council would not vote for the canal, as it was conditioned that the city should construct and maintain a sixteen-foot roadway along the entire length of the canal, as such a roadway would cost more than the amount of money which the county proposed to give.

He did not think that the county had any right to ask the city to wire and furnish the water and electric utilities for the county buildings, as proposed in the proposition of the county. It looked to him as though the county would be asked to pay for the construction of the city building, all of the bridges over the canal from Seymour park to the county line and keep them in repair for ninety-nine years was a sum of \$200,000.

Prepared a Resolution. G. R. Williams remarked that the time for action had arrived. All that there was to do was to introduce a resolution, ordering the submission, and then adopt it or vote it down.

Chairman Stenberg said that he had instructed Assistant County Attorney Troup to prepare a resolution and that it was now in the hands of the city council.

The resolution as prepared recites the fact that the county of Douglas will vote bonds to aid in the construction of a canal from August 1, 1894, to twenty years from date and at an interest at the rate of 4 1/2 per cent, payable semi-annually; that none of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds are to be used for the city of Omaha until it is shown that the sum of \$1,000,000 has actually been expended in the construction of the canal; that \$500,000 of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds are to be used for the city of Omaha for a period of six months from August 1, 1894; that the city shall have exclusive control of the canal from the date of its completion to the date of the expiration of the term of ninety-nine years after the completion of the canal; that the city will furnish to the county, free of charge, water, light and power for all the county buildings and institutions.

A proposition was also submitted to the effect that the city shall construct and maintain a roadway ten feet wide and ten feet above the water line, with three inches of the district acting as the arbitrators.

Resulted in a Tie. Chairman Stenberg said that it had been demonstrated to his entire satisfaction that the canal would be a great benefit to both the city and the county, and as such he believed that it was the duty of the board to allow the people of the county to say whether or not they would vote for the bonds. As servants of the public the members of the board had no authority to take arbitrary action and throttle the proposition.

After discussing the matter for two hours a vote was reached, with Messrs. Stenberg and Padlock voting for the proposition, Messrs. Livesey and Williams voting against submission.

COUNCIL TAKES ACTION

Ordinance Creating a Canal Commission Passed at a Special Session.

The ordinance creating the waterworks commission for the construction of the Platte river canal and defining its powers and duties was passed at a special session of the city council yesterday afternoon.

The ordinance was introduced by Mr. Stenberg and was approved by a vote of 10 to 2. The ordinance was passed at length by all members present before a vote was reached.

Mr. S. L. Wiley, one of the promoters of the Platte canal project, was seen last night after the commission had been organized to submit the proposition to the voters at the next election. He said that the city could not afford to accept the proposition that had been considered by the commissioners even if they had voted to pass it, as the conditions attached were such that the city would be loser by a large amount.

He said that the county's claim to the embankments along the proposed canal was unproven, and that the city would receive no revenue to the city, as the roadways could be rented to electric railways at a handsome profit and it is doubtful if the city could afford to build the bridges and other improvements required by the county's conditions would cost more than the amount of any bond issue that the city could raise. Wiley said he was of the opinion that the county's action would have no effect upon the project, but that it would be taken up and carried to a successful completion by the city.
