OMAHA LIVE STOCK MARKETS

Fairly Liberal Receipts of All Sorts Find Trade in Bad Shape.

CATTLE FROM STEADY TO A DIME LOWER

Eastern Advances Decidedly Bearish and Promptly Acted On by the Dealers—Hogs Drop Five Cents, but Cows Active—Cattle Strong.

Supplies of all kinds continue fairly liberal, receipts for the past three days showing an increase of 600 cattle, 1,400 sheep and 3,500 hogs over the first half of last week.

The price of cattle was not very heavy, but following Tuesday's liberal supply and in the face of a heavy run and a lower market at Chicago, 3,100 cattle were today, and prices ruled lower, with a slow, dull trade.

All classes of buyers were in the market, but all wanted the cattle lower, and started in bidding lower prices from the first.

The general average of prices bid and paid was about a dime lower than Tuesday. Some hardly coveting the decline on some of the less desirable heavy cattle.

The trading in stockers and feeders was mostly confined to yard traders, and was very slow at that.

The demand is at present poor, the supply large, and prices fully a quarter lower than last week.
