Mackey, which has been detailed to guard the Rock Island road, missed death at the hands of the Pond Creek train wreckers at 1 o'clock this morning by less than 200 feet. Two explosions of dynamite occurred within 200 yards of the south outskirts of the city immediately after the special train carrying the troops from Enid to Pond Creek station had passed.
