ECHOES FROM THE ANTE ROOM

Catholics Do Not Take kindly to the Recent Papal Decree.

MANY WILL STAY WITH THE ORDERS

They Claim that as Americans Pope Leo Cannot Curtail Their Rights—Local Lodges Assisting in Relief Work

Doing Relief Work

Reports that are coming in to the headquarters of the suffering in the western part of the state, show that want will be widespread, but not so great as has been reported.

Interested circles are eagerly watching the outcome of the papal decree placing the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, the Knights of Pythias and the Sons of Temperance in the list of societies forbidden to Catholics.

The first question to answer can be obtained from comment of any kind and seem as unconcerned as though the decree had not been issued. The clergy maintain that the penalty attached, the denial of the sacraments, will in time produce the desired effect.

But there is seen a very large doubt whether the penalty is self-operative. Compulsively the priest cannot prevent a man in the confessional regarding membership in forbidden societies, so that a man who believes membership is not a sin is under no obligations, other than that of obedience, to tell it. Obedience would be a powerful factor in determining the result were it not that the decree is lessened by opposition.

The decree has not been promulgated in a majority of the dioceses as yet and without force until so promulgated. According to the rules, it must be promulgated within thirty days after its receipt, but should a bishop, for sufficient cause, withhold promulgation, he is at liberty to do so.

His reasons must be forwarded to Rome, and if approved the decree will have no effect in his diocese. It is asserted by Catholic clergymen that this condition is solely to obtain assent of the laity, and that the result of an expert hearing by the laity is to be forwarded to the pope.
