There Was Such an Avalanche of Offerings that the Value Was Instantly Crushed to a Low Point Early. CHICAGO, Jan. 22.—Longs continued to dump their wheat on the market today, and under the heavy load May option touched 54c.

The liquidation of long wheat, which was the feature of yesterday's trade, had not ended as apparent as soon as the reason opened this morning. Commission houses had more wheat for sale, and May at the 54c bid was immediately advanced at the opening at 55c down to 54c for May, there was such an avalanche of offerings that the value was instantly crushed to 52c, being a still lower level than the low level of yesterday's quotations.
