Custard Pudding. One and one-half pint milk, four eggs, one cupful sugar, two teaspoonfuls Royal Extract Vanilla. Beat eggs and sugar together, dilute with milk and extract; pour into buttered pudding dish, set in oven in deep pan of water, boil about 45 minutes in double boiler.
