LOST HIS SELF-POSSESSION

Appearance of Miss Yoke on the Stand Too Much for Holmes. TOLD THE STORY OF THEIR WANDERINGS. Holmes Swindled Mrs. Pitzel Out of Her Share of the Insurance Money on a Bonus Note-Was Man of Many Wives.

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 31.-When the priviledged persons had been permitted to enter the court room in which the trial of Holmes is proceeding there appeared by almost as many women as men present. Most of them had seats in the space usually reserved for witnesses.

Holmes, as calm and unmoved as ever, was placed in the dock at 10 o'clock. His counsel promptly went to him and a long and earnest colloquy ensued. Holmes did most of the talking, and was apparently offering suggestions, or, perhaps, giving orders. He appeared to be brighter and more cheerful than at any time since the trial began, and after his counsel had resumed their seats he chatted and laughed with two court officials stationed next to the little cage in which he sat.

The first witness of the day proved to be a lively one. This was Sidney L. Samuels, a member of the bar of Fort Worth, Tex., a young, cleanly shaven man, with a twinkling eye and the utmost self-possession. He spoke quickly and sharply, and invariably referred to Holmes as "the individual." This annoyed even Holmes, who smiled toward him whenever the term was used. District Attorney Graham produced the note identified by Mrs. Pitzel yesterday as the one Holmes pretended to take to the St. Louis bank, and for which purpose he took \$5,000 from her. Mr. Samuels said the body of the note was in his handwriting. In the latter part of April or early in May, 1894, he was in Fort Worth a man known as H. M. Pratt. It was "this individual," he was overreaching the St. Louis bank, and supposed owner, Pratt came to the witness and tried to negotiate a loan of \$10,000 by mortgaging the note, and after some talk the note was drawn and signed by Benton T. Lyman. It was dated May 14, 1894. Subsequently Pratt claimed to have been endorsed by the loan bank, however, second note similar to this. The note was originally drawn to the order of P. S. Samuels, brother of the witness. The note was never endorsed, but the loan bank, however, identified both the original notes and the substitute. Mr. Graham sought to prove that the note was never a legal document.
