CHICAGO, July 1.—Extreme activity in wheat at the start today was followed by dullness. September delivery was 10c below yesterday's close. Corn, oats and provisions all closed easier.

Wheat had a range for the day of 1c. The feeling developed was a little mixed, the feeling better in the morning and closing out later, the final figures showing from 1/2c to 1c decline.
