The report was set for hearing on the second day of the next term of court. SHAKES UP LOAN ASSOCIATIONS. New town Loan Will Be the Death of Several Organizations. DES MOINES, Aug. 16.—(Special).—The prospects are that the state executive council will have some serious trouble before it gets done with the building and loan associations. The trouble grows out of the law passed last winter requiring the associations to come under the supervision of the state. The requirement is that they shall reorganize and that the articles filed shall set forth all the details of their plan of conducting business. These articles are subject to the inspection and approval of the executive council. The law went into effect July 1 and the council has since received two months, or till September 4, to comply with its requirements. There are about 150 of them to file reports and many of them are that a good many of them will be suspended from transacting business when the days of grace expire, because they will have failed to comply with the law. The fact is that the council is discovering a good deal of very queer business methods in connection with the management of building and loan associations. Many of them have not and many of them are not likely to do so.
