PULL TIME IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Little Ones to Get a Whole Day at School After the Holidays.

The Board of Education took a radical departure from its usual manner of doing business last night and transacted its business without a single speech.

The following report from the special committee on tenure of office was read and laid over for two weeks.

We believe that before an employee of the school system can be dismissed the permanent list, an experience of at least one year in the schools is required.

It will be observed that only teachers and janitors are included in this report. No change is made in the salary schedule.

The regular teachers' examination was held at the school for the first time since the change in the method of holding the examination.

The report of Treasurer Edwards showed a balance of \$2,752.50 in the school fund at the end of November.

Superintendent Pearce reported the school membership November 25 as 15,724, or 525 below the membership at the corresponding date a year ago.

MANY AMENDMENTS TO CHARTER

City Council Committee Knocks Out The city council charter amendment committee did a pile of amending in the couple of hours during which it met in the city hall last night.

By the proposed amendments the Board of Public Works was abolished and a substitute was suggested by Haas to consist of the mayor, the president of the city council and the city engineer.

Another amendment that was adopted cut down the number of park commissioners from five to three and placed their appointments under the control of the mayor and council.

The charter thus amended the Mayor has the power of appointing only the building inspector, the boiler inspector and the city prosecutor.

Another amendment that was adopted provided that the city treasurer should give bonds of \$200,000 from some security company or companies approved by the mayor or council.

This completes the revision of the charter with the exception of the section on fire which was not tackled last night.
