Ways and Means Committee Listens to Further Arguments.  
DIFFERENCE OF OPINION AS TO LEAD  
Smelters and Miners Do Not Agree on the Subject—Pertinent Facts Pertaining to the Production of Nickel.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 9.—The house committee on ways and means reached the iron and steel schedule today. The first speaker before the committee was Representative Draper of Massachusetts. In behalf of the iron and steel manufacturers of New England, he advocated the restoration of the McKinley rate.

W. H. Alexander of the Grant Smelting company of Omaha spoke for lower rates on lead ore, asking a provision that the lead in all ores containing lead be made dutiable at three-fourths of a cent a pound.

Representative Herdman of Oregon recommended a duty of ten cents a pound on nickel. He also proposed a resolution in 1891 authorizing the secretary of the navy to purchase for \$1,000,000 worth of nickel for armor plate.
