Railroads of the Great Transmississippi Region.

MILEAGE REACHES INTO THE THOUSANDS

Complete List of Roads Operating in the Twenty-Four States and Territories that Will Be Represented at the Exposition.

The following is a complete list of the railroads operating in the twenty-four transmississippi states and territories together with their mileage and terminal. In this list mention is made only of the portions of the railroads in the states west of the Mississippi river. Many of these lines operate in other states also. The list was compiled from the Official Railway Guide of the United States:

Total mileage, 115 miles. Operates a line from Duluth to Mountain Iron and other points in Minnesota. Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway—Total mileage, 6,151 miles. Operates through the states of Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, North Dakota and Minnesota. Through lines from Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul to Omaha, Kansas City, Chamberlain, S. D., and Fargo, N. D. Various connecting and branch lines between its main lines in these states.

12 miles. Operates in Arkansas, from Paragould to Cardwell. Omaha & St. Louis Railway—Mileage, 144 miles. Operates in Missouri and Iowa, from Pattonsburg to Council Bluffs. Colorado Eastern Railway—Mileage, 17 miles. Operates in Colorado, from Denver to Brainerd to Walker. Black Hills & Fort Pierre Railroad—Mileage, 36.4 miles. Operates in South Dakota, from Lead City to Piedmont.

—Mileage, 1,028 miles. Operates in Oregon from Portland to Huntington, branch lines and several steamship lines. Kansas City, Fort Scott & Memphis Railroad—Mileage, 1,220 miles. Operates in Missouri, Kansas and Arkansas, from Kansas City to Memphis. Lake Charles & Leesville Railway—Mileage, 38 miles. Operates in Louisiana, from Lake Charles to Alexandria.

Kansas, Indian Territory and Texas, from Hannibal, St. Louis and Kansas City to Galveston. Sherman, Shreveport & Southern Railway—Mileage, 153 miles. Operates in Texas, from Jefferson to McKinney. Santa Fe, Prescott & Phoenix Railway—Mileage, 196.6 miles. Operates in Arizona from Phoenix to Ash Fork. Cheyenne, Oklahoma & Gulf Railroad—Mileage, 25.1 miles. Operates in Oklahoma and Indian Territory from Wister to Fort Reno.

Arkansas, Indian Territory and Texas, from Hannibal, St. Louis and Kansas City to Galveston. Sherman, Shreveport & Southern Railway—Mileage, 153 miles. Operates in Texas, from Jefferson to McKinney. Santa Fe, Prescott & Phoenix Railway—Mileage, 196.6 miles. Operates in Arizona from Phoenix to Ash Fork. Cheyenne, Oklahoma & Gulf Railroad—Mileage, 25.1 miles.
