Wheat Fluctuates a Little, but Closes Without Change.
REACHES UP TO A THREE-FOURTHS RISE
Liverpool Cables Are Disappointing and Northwestern Receipts Heavy - Corn and Oats Neglected and Close Lower.

CHICAGO, Feb. 5.—Wheat, after fluctuating all day at 1 1/2c, closed at substantially yesterday's final figure. It sold at one time at a 3c advance, but rallied near the close carried prices down again. Corn and oats were neglected, and closed a shade lower, the weakness being more marked in oats than in corn. Provisions were weak and declined 2 1/2c to 7c.

What was subject at the opening to much the same sort of influences as it was Thursday morning. The Liverpool market was rather disappointing, because the advance was only 1/2c to begin with. Both New York and Chicago houses doing an export business reported that they had no foreign acceptance of wheat or corn offers made to the United Kingdom and continent yesterday.

Provisions were heavy and prices advanced. The market for hogs was the most interesting. The market weakened slightly in the early afternoon, but rallied in the afternoon to a close at 17c 1/2, up from 17c. The closing price was 17c 1/2.
