

CONDITION OF OMAHA'S TRADE

Values as Well as Volume of Business Have an Upward Tendency.

MONEY GENERALLY EASY IN THE COUNTRY

Local Jobbers Report a Large Business, While Retail Trade Hums Ahead of Last Year. High Prices at South Omaha.

The middle of August has arrived and business is laying aside the characteristics of the summer season and putting on its fall garb. In most lines the volume of trade is gradually increasing with each week and there is no reason to believe that it will be in any way less than it has been in the past few weeks.

Among the retailers of the city there has been no great activity noticeable the past week, for the reason that the season is so far advanced that customers cannot be expected to buy freely of summer goods and it is not late enough for them to take hold of fall goods.

Even in the case of the business situation it is as good as any one could ask for. Every jobbing house in the city is busy and is expected to be so for the remainder of the year. The retail trade is also doing well and is expected to be so for the remainder of the year.

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A matter of more than passing interest is the material gain in the bank clearings of this city as compared with the same time last year. This shows a marked increase in the volume of business done in the city.

Rumors of Fruit and French Tariff Changes Send Threat skyward.

GAINS FULLY TWO AND A HALF CENTS

Corn Advances Steadily on Account of Rumored Cold and in Sympathy with Wheat. Oats and Provisions Steady.

CHICAGO, Aug. 14.—The shorts in wheat had another shaking up today and Sept. 15th advanced 2 1/2c from the low point and retained an improvement of 2 1/2c over the previous day's closing.

Wheat opened 2 1/2c higher than it closed yesterday's session, the opening price for September being 53 1/2c to 54c, and for October 52 1/2c to 53c.
