Breaking of the Drouth Has Little Effect on the Wheat Market. PRICE DROPS ONLY A SMALL FRACTION

Corn and Oats Show Slightly Larger Losses, Oats Going Down Over a Cent—Provisions Firm and Higher.

CHICAGO, Oct. 11.—A decline of but 1/16 cent was recorded as the effect that the breaking of the drouth had on the wheat market.

December wheat, which closed Friday at 92 1/4, opened today at 92 3/4. This was the result of the rain, which the weather bureau reported covering nearly all the drouth-stricken districts.
