TRANSACTION A MERE MATTER OF FORM

Big Horn Southern Line, Bought by Burlington Capital, Will Hereafter Be Operated from Headquarters in Omaha.

By a mere act of bookkeeping the Big Horn Southern railway, extending in Montana from Billings to the southern boundary of the state, a distance of 150 miles, has been changed from a leased line of the Burlington system to a line owned and controlled by the Burlington & Missouri River railroad.
