Good Milling Demand and Heavy Exports Advance Wheat Again. STRENGTH IS SHOWN IN ALL THE OPTIONS

Wheat is especially higher, while corn and provisions each show some little advance.

CHICAGO, Jan. 7.—Good milling demand and heavy exports again made a strong wheat market today out of a rather weak one, the May option closing at 11c advance over yesterday's figure.

Wheat opened a shade under yesterday's closing price, but soon recovered. For an hour the market was steadily but cautiously upward. The early slight decline was due in part to reports of rain in California yesterday.

The Minneapolis and Duluth receipts of wheat on Jan. 7 were 107,000 bushels, compared with 117,000 bushels for the same day of last year.

The market for corn broadened out today and trading was firm and active. General prices were held by the strong demand for oats by the small country offerings.

Provisions, which had been especially active yesterday, showed some weakness today. The market at first showed some inclination toward weakness, but the strength developed later.
