Grain and Provisions Here Uninterrupted Rise.

VISIBLE DECREASE STRENGTHENS WHEAT

International Advances Are Reported From Foreign Markets and May Bring Closer Over Five Cents Higher Than on Saturday.

CHICAGO, April 25.—An extraordinary and almost uninterrupted rise took place today on the Board of Trade in the value of grain and provisions. May wheat closed 1/4 higher than Saturday; July grain 1/2; corn and oats, 1/4; pork, 1/2; beef, 1/2; and ribs, 1/2 each.

Sensational advances in foreign and outside domestic markets, a decrease of over 2,000,000 bu. in the visible supply of wheat and small world's shipments caused the upturn in wheat, which all other markets followed. Although Liverpool opening cables today quoted wheat at 3c a bushel higher, the market displayed a bullish tendency after the first rush of trading, and throughout the session gave evidence of heavy liquidation on hard spots.
