General List of Stocks Show Few Changes and Small Gains Are Held.

NEW YORK, July 21.—There was no reaction to the closing of the stock market today. A few of the industrial specialties were pushed up on considerations individual to the stock.

These had some sympathetic effect on the general list, which showed slight changes in prices.

All these gains were held, but prices at the close showed small net gains as a rule.

Rubber, Leather, Metropolitan, Lead and Cotton oil were all advanced quite materially, and there was a slight advance in the price of sugar.

London was a small buyer on balance.

The speculation in the wheat market had its reflection in the stock market, though the fact is now a matter of course.

There was a wheat crop of unprecedented proportions. Of rather more significance was today's report from the Bureau of Agriculture, which showed a very large crop of Roumanian wheat, supplementing yesterday's report of an expected increase in the French crop.

Current prices for the future deliveries of wheat show a tendency to spread from the prices ruling at the corresponding period of last year, the active speculation in the grain market at this time has been confined to European crops and the prospective heavy harvest of the fall.

There is a heavy crop of wheat in New York and the prices for the corresponding period of last year are being maintained.

The interrupted grain movement already shows signs of recovery and a good export demand gives hope that the market will be well maintained and the movement of the new crop continued.
