

The incident was turned into a bit of pleasantry and was passed. The finance ommittee, on recommendation of the city tiorney, also struck out of the appropriaion sheet items in favor of the Barber Asphalt Paving company and the Grant Paving company of \$8,466,12 and \$2,908,42, respectively, for repairing asphalt streets all over the city during the last six months of 1898. Some question has arisen recently whether the cost of these repairs should be paid out of the general fund of the city or Monday, April 3rd should be assessed up against adjoining property and the proposition was submitted o the city attorney. The latter gave it as his opinion that under the city charter the council is required to assess the cost of repairs and recommended that the matter b nore thoroughly considered at the committee of the whole meeting of the council next Monday afternoon. This recommendation was adopted. If the view of the city attorney prevails it is said that no asphalt street in the city will be repaired, unless the property owners adjoining petition for it and pay the cost through taxation. The appropriation sheet also set aside for se \$599 out of the \$2,500 allotted to the Board of Public Works for street repairs Layriz during the year.
