Chiefs of the Various Departments to Come West-Omaha to Be Visited in July.

Mr. Rogers will address the National Educational association in Los Angeles, July 12, on the Paris exposition, and will also de-liver addresses on the same subject in San Francisco, Salt Lake City and Omaha during July.
