Street Commissioner Ross is doing very little work just now. During January a large number of crosswalks were laid and many sidewalks were repaired.

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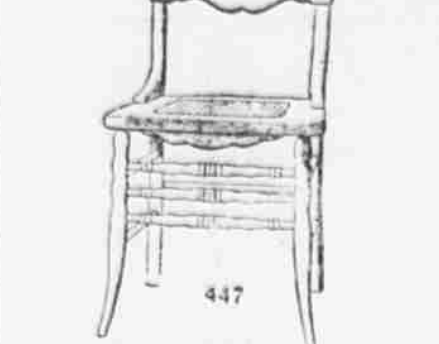

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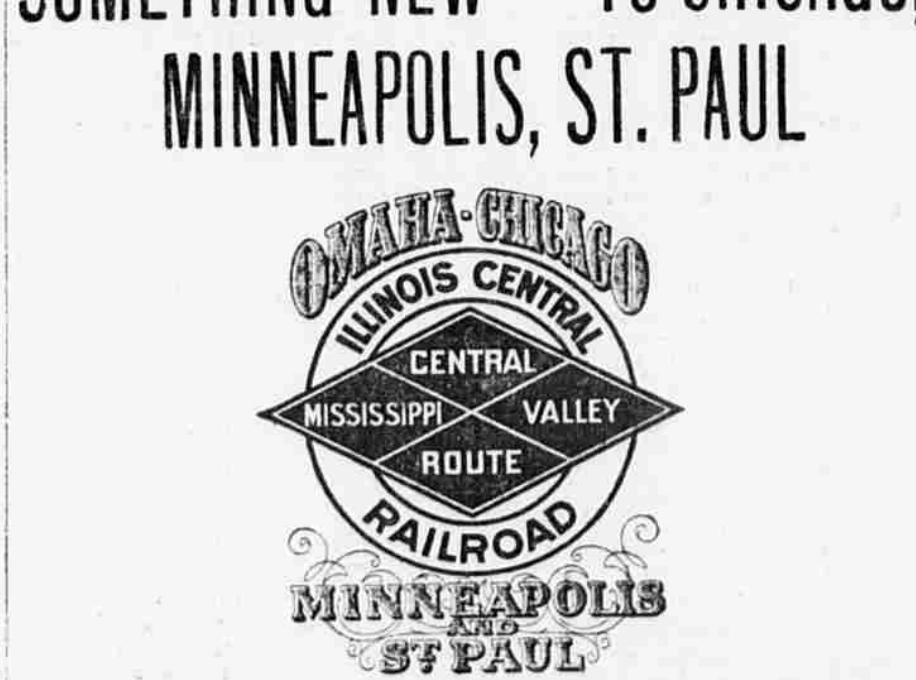
