More Favorable View of French Wheat Crop
Prospect Makes Wheat Weaker

TRADE IN WHEAT DULL WITH PARIS LOWER

Oats Market Quiet and Depressed by Weakness in Wheat-Corn Market
Colorless-Provisions Opened Firm-Hogs Are Weak.

CHICAGO, Feb. 9.—A more favorable view of the French wheat crop prospect, failure of the cold wave to fulfill predictions and languoriness in the export demand made a weak wheat market today.

The market was quiet and depressed somewhat by the weakness of wheat. The trade in wheat was dull. Paris was lower and Liverpool also depressed and, although May wheat opened a shade up at 87 1/2¢, a reaction quickly followed.
