

DIDN'T DO A THING TO THEM

St. Joseph's Aggregation of Omaha and Back Numbers Patten Biting Average.

EGAN AND MACKAY WERE READY MONEY

Twenty-eight Hits and Fifty-five Runs Were All the Filippinos Cared for on a Sultry Afternoon.

It must have been in the air yesterday. At any rate Omaha was not the only one as witness the record shown by the games at Denver, New York, Philadelphia, Milwaukee and other places in the baseball map. The Missourians lambasted the two Omaha pitchers who essayed to do business in the center of the diamond for the Colts in a total of twenty-five runs and the Champions were lucky to muster up a collection of runs reaching one-fifth as many.

Notwithstanding this awful slaughter of the innocents—for such were the offerings dished up by Egan and Mackay—the game by no means a farce. The Saints had their batting and fielding on good and each player boosted up his batting average without any apparent effort. They swatted the ball right and left and made Fitcher Mackay look like a dunce. The carriage began in the very first inning. Rip Egan started out to do the pitching act for the Champs and the first man who faced him, Strang, soaked a fly over second base. Matthew McVicker had hardly warmed up to his usual temperature and consequently didn't exert himself to corral the leacher. Instead he tried to catch the first bound, but the ball indulged in an eccentricity peculiar to base balls and bounced away from Mattie's outstretched mitts. Thereupon did Strang sail down to second base. The next batter, one Hall by name, tipped a sickly grounder to Tomman. The kid picked up the ball and was stricken with cerebral paralysis. He debauched in his mind whether to forward the ball over to Hoy and cut off Strang at third or fire it to Robesman and annihilate Hall. The first proposition was finally decided upon, but it availed naught for Robesman reached third safely and in the next Hall proceeded on to second.

These performances had a rather discouraging effect on Rip Egan and his cup of sorrow was filled to overflowing when King, the third batter, reached first on a palpable fielding blunder of Strang. After that Rip was unable to contain himself, his grief was so great, and it was really a matter of seemingly providential intervention that the first ball of the first inning was not continued indefinitely. After the whole St. Joe mob had batted around on Omaha's mound and Hall had taken another whack at Rip the side was retired. Eight big juicy tallies were copped out by the Saints and the Champions realized that they were up against the real thing. They started in with a considerable energy, however, and in their half of the first inning a couple of runs were scored. In the second inning Mackay succeeded Egan on the rubber. LONG LIVE THE NEW QUEEN

Miss Maud Williams Captures a Large Vote, Capturing the Crews.

IN THE BELL'S FREE VACATION CONTEST

Had but 1,000 Votes to Friday, but Held a Pair of Loaded Steeplechases—One Additional New Member Joins Regal Set.

While the voting yesterday was not as brisk as on the closing day of last week it has brought out by far the greatest surprise since the opening of the contest.
