

NEW DRESS FOR THE STREETS

Board of Public Works Annonnees the Low Bidders on Several Important Paving Contracts.

Bids for the paving of Twenty-fourth street from SL Mary's avenue to Dodge street and for the paying of Dodge street between Thirty-eighth and Fortieth streets were opened by the Board of Public Works. The Barber Asphalt company's bid was the lowest on asphalt, its price on the Twentyfourth street work being \$1.93 per square yard on a five-year guaranty, and \$2.17 on a ten-year guaranty. W. P. Mumaugh's bid was lowest on brick, his price on the Twenty-fourth street work being \$1.21 per square yard and his bid on the Dodge street paving \$1.80 per square yard. C. D. Woodworth submitted the lowest bid on curbing. He made a price of 62 cents per lineal foot on Berea and Bedford stone and 68 cents per lineal foot on Lyons stone.




