METALS—There was a sharp "squeeze" in the London market for iron and tin, and prices were accordingly advanced. Lead advanced some 35 cents in sympathy and closed strong at 29.625c.87c. An increase of 10c. was in the world stock. Tin had no material of its own to offer. Iron warrants were dull at 19.50c.10.00. Lake copper was quiet and unchanged at 31.50c. Zinc, London, was steady at 21.50c. Lead was unchanged on the basis of 41.50c. and 41.45c. respectively. The brokers' price for lead was 43 and for copper 56.50c.

OMAHA WHOLESALE MARKETS.

Condition of Trade and Quotations on Staples and Fancy Produce.

CHICAGO, Oct. 2.—Wheat was active and firm early, but turned heavy on the large world's visible increase, November closing 14c./4c. under yesterday. Corn closed 4c./4c. higher and oats a shade down. Provisions were mixed.

The trade in wheat was small and featureless. November opened at 77c./77c. Liverpool was higher, northwest receipts light, the weather of that section bad, with prospects of more of the same kind, and the market of the spring wheat territory firm. The crop was bullish on this kind of news at the start and was further strengthened by its views by a Board of trade announcement of wet weather and poor crop prospects in northern Argentina. The market peaked November 10, at 78c./78c. A fall-off in sales dropped to 77c./77c. A falling off in unmarketable western receipts followed, but a slight rally, November 11, was due to a movement of an otherwise dead market of Argentine bushels in the world's market. Sales of Argentine bushels are the only ones which have been made since the closing of the market. Demand and price strong and receipts steady. Receipts, 15 cars.
