Lack of Public Support Again Results Disastrously for Wheat.

CORN STEADY EARLY, BUT GROWS WEAKER

Business in Oats is of the Slimmest Proportions—Provisions Are Quiet and Weak Under Influence of Heavy Hog Receipts.

CHICAGO, Oct. 10.—Lack of public support again resulted disastrously for wheat today, December closing was under par for the day. Corn closed steady but weaker. The chief grain trade is now in the September options. Provisions closed lower.

The wheat market held fairly steady during the forenoon under influence of a choice and the cash buying from May 1930 bushels, were sold here for export.

December opened at 104.75, traded 103.75, dropped to 103.25, and then rallied to 103.75. Shorts were the best buyers. No particular cash support was forthcoming, however.

But in its stead there was selling by St. Louis interests. This developed the market lower, who unloaded December under the pressure declined to 103.40, at which point it closed.

New York reported 22 1/2 cent basis taken for export. December in wheat and flour were equal to 3.00 bushels, compared with 1.25-1.50 bushels last year. Minneapolis and St. Paul reported 27 cent basis, 42 cent last week and 36 a year ago. Local receipts were 212 carloads, compared with 140 carloads reported several weeks ago.

The government report after trading hours, as current basis, is 27 1/2 cent. Corn was dull and though steady early finally eased in sympathy with wheat without weakness. This developed the market lower.

Provisions were quiet and weak under the influence of heavy hog receipts. January pork sold between 11.20 and 11.30, and closed 11.20. The market was 1/2 cent lower. Estimated receipts for the week are 200 cars, 100 hogs, 200 sheep, 200 calves, 200 pigs.
