Oats Decline in Sympathy with Wheat and Corn—Soybean Are Quiet—Roughs Though Market Opened Easy.

CHICAGO, Nov. 10.—Wheat was dull, December having sagged on liberal receipts, absence of better foreign demand and other bearish considerations, closed weak, 5c under Wednesday. November corn dropped 6c on liquidation and December closed 6c down. Oats closed 1/4c depressed and protons 1/4c down. Soybean were steady. Market opened easy.
