HEALTH DEPARTMENT TAKES HIM

Removal of Queer Old Shoemaker Reveals Other Cases of Disease in His Neighborhood and Quarantine is Established.

For two weeks Peter Offbeiter suffered with smallpox in a dark hallway beneath the Tenth street viaduct.

Yesterday he was discovered by the health authorities and removed to the emergency hospital.

Offbeiter is an eccentric old shoemaker who has his workshop and residence in a narrow hallway at 615 South Tenth street.

He lived alone and was seldom visited by anybody but patients. Two weeks ago the old man was taken sick. He would not permit his neighbors to come into his shop and cared for himself.

Mrs. Mattie Boxen, a daughter of Offbeiter, heard of her father's sickness, and went to see him. The old man would not allow her to enter the shop. He told her that he had the smallpox. She reported the case to the health authorities, who made an investigation and found that the man's statements were true.

Removal to Hospital. Offbeiter was removed to the emergency hospital. The rest of the ambulance attracted a large crowd of neighbors to the shoemaker's door and the health authorities were amazed to see a man in the crowd who had a well defined case of smallpox.

Investigation proved that the man's name is Frank Alvy. He lives 622 South Tenth street and has exposed the entire neighborhood to the disease.

When asked what was wrong with him, he replied, "Chickenpox. What did you think I had?"

The doctor assured him that he was recovering from a severe attack of smallpox and ordered him and all other persons who live in the same house quarantined.

New Cases Expected.

Nellie Alvy, John Van Housen and two small children have been quarantined in the house with Alvy.

The health officers have taken every precaution to prevent the further spread of the disease in that neighborhood, but say that it will be miraculous if new cases do not develop.

It sometimes think that the health department will be compelled to make a house-to-house visitation before it can stamp out smallpox," remarked Dr. J. B. Raup, assistant to the city health commissioner.

People are careless about the disease and fail to report it to the authorities. In districts where physicians are not called frequently the disease is overlooked.

It is probable that a systematic investigation of all cases of sickness will be begun.

DAUGHERTY IS A PARADOX

Nebraska Politician Attracts Attention in Washington Because of His Unusual Mixture.

Matt Daugherty of Ogallala, one of the prominent cattlemen in western Nebraska, was in the city Thursday enroute to his home from Washington, where he has been for the last two weeks.

"I went to Washington for a double purpose," said Mr. Daugherty. "One was to witness the inauguration ceremonies of President McKinley and the other to bring up a matter of great importance as a member of the United States land office at Sidney. In the great crowd of people who throng the national capital from one year's end to the other I was singled out as a paradox.

Most men who go there are seekers of political preferment. As a matter of fact it is a common saying that a man once elevated to a political office never is content to let go until he is fired out bodily or gets too feeble to draw his salary.

"Well, when the fact was discovered that I was in Washington after a vacation of an office was looked upon as a sort of political monstrosity. I am going to devote my entire attention in the future to the cattle business. And by the way, the cattle industry in western Nebraska was never in such a better position as at this time. M'Connan's arrest will be made on a charge of assault and battery.
