WHEAT OPENS UP STRONG AND ACTIVE

No Relief from Dry, Searching Heat in Southern Corn Belt—Tendency of Provisions Market Necessarily Upward.

CHICAGO, July 12.—Under the influence of continued drought prices of all grains again opened higher today and September contracts closed 2 1/2c higher than yesterday.
